New Student Admissions Checklist

Kindergarten

- Complete and return Student & Family Information Sheet and \$100 Application Fee.
- Financial Aid: Complete the financial aid applications online from **F.A.S.T.** and return with required documentation. <https://www.cjdschool.org/admissions/tuition-and-financial-aid/>
- Schedule school testing at Charlotte Jewish Day School & submit \$80 testing and interpretation fee.
- Schedule psycho-educational testing and remit \$250 directly to psychologist. **(See Guide to New Student Testing)**
- Have your child's preschool teacher complete the preschool teacher evaluation form and return it to CJDS.
- Submit copies of any & all educational, cognitive, social and behavioral evaluations including speech & occupational therapy.

After the school has received the items above, along with the results from educational testing, you will be invited to have a meeting with the Head of School.

- Parent Admissions Meeting with the Head of School & Assistant Director

Receipt of application, fees, test results and teacher recommendation forms will ensure consideration for admissions.

A letter will confirm your child's acceptance into Charlotte Jewish Day School.

Grades 1—5

- Complete and return Student & Family Information Sheet and \$100 Application Fee.
- Financial Aid: Complete the financial aid applications online from **F.A.S.T.** and return with required documentation. <https://www.cjdschool.org/admissions/tuition-and-financial-aid/>
- Schedule school testing at Charlotte Jewish Day School & submit \$80 testing and interpretation fee.
- Schedule psycho-educational testing and remit \$250 directly to psychologist. **(See Guide to New Student Testing)**
- Have your child's elementary school teacher complete the school evaluation form and return it to CJDS.
- Submit copies of any & all educational, cognitive, social and behavioral evaluations including speech & occupational therapy.
- Complete the request for student records form so CJDS may obtain your child's transcripts.

After the school has received the items above, along with the results from educational testing, you will be invited to have a meeting with the Head of School.

- Parent Admissions Meeting with the Head of School & Assistant Director.
- Student Interview with the Director & Assistant Director (Grades 2—5)

Receipt of application, fees, test results and teacher recommendation forms will ensure consideration for admissions.

A letter will confirm your child's acceptance into Charlotte Jewish Day School.
